OUTDOOR RUG CARE & MAINTENANCE

Supplies Needed:

1. Eye protection
2. Mild soap
3. Water

Always wear eye protection to prevent foreign liquid or material from entering the eye.

Prevention

The best way to maintain the look and feel of your outdoor rug is to first take measures to prevent it from unnecessary exposure. Try to discourage people wearing excessively muddy shoes from using the rug. If your rug becomes wet either from moisture in the air or rain, remove the rug to an area with good circulation so that it can dry thoroughly.

Moisture under the rug increases the chances of mold or mildew growth.

Cleaning

To remove built up dirt or grime, and for routine cleaning, make a solution of mild soap and water. Gently wash any soiled areas with mild soap and water. Rinse the rug thoroughly. Allow the rug to dry completely, sometimes one side will appear dry but the other may still be damp.

Before replacing the rug, examine the area of the floor for any signs of soiling or mildew. If you notice any soil or mildew clean your floor appropriately, before laying the rug back down.
